TG11402 A-Frame Bridge over Wensum – Plywood and Horse Matting Replacement

An inspection carried out on bridge TG11402 'A-Frame Bridge over Wensum' identified deterioration in the Marine Plywood and Rubber Horse Matting surface.

A scheme to renew this ply and horse matting has now been scheduled and the work will require a bridge closure to ensure the safety of the public during installation.

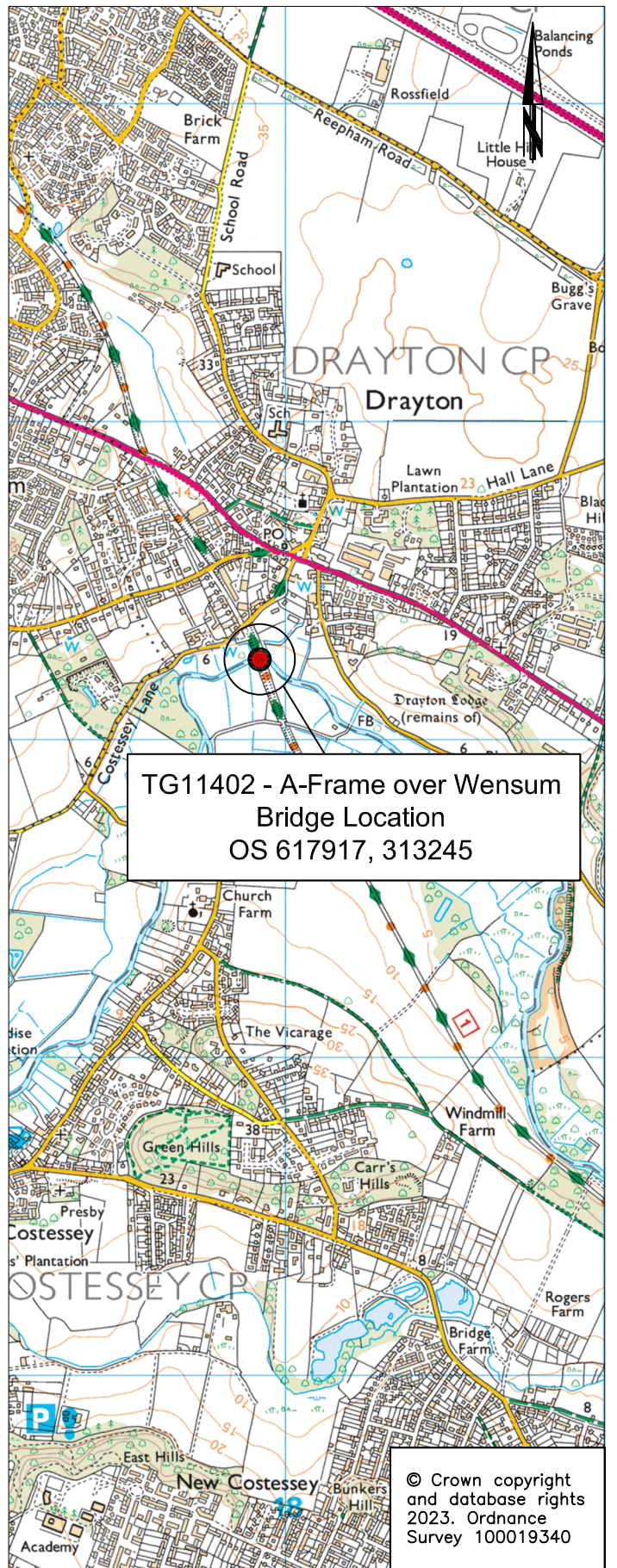
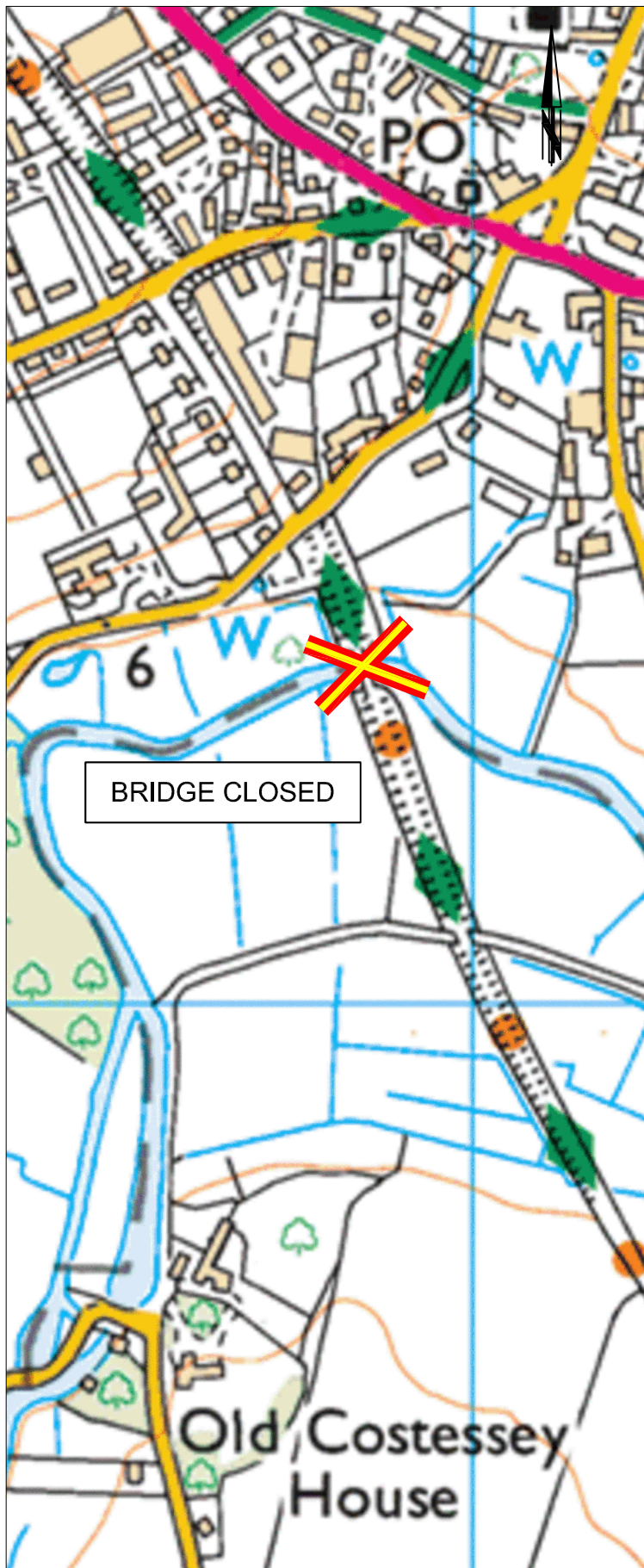
The expected start date is Tuesday 29th August 2023. It is likely the scheme will take 2 weeks to complete, potentially finishing on 8th September 2023 or sooner. Our Contractor Tarmac has recommended a closure at the bridge due to the type of work required, and for the safety of the public.

A diversion route of equivalent 'Permissive' status is not available, but the Marriotts Way can be used on a 'to the bridge and back' basis until the work has been completed.
