

MINUTES OF DRAYTON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

Held on Thursday 6th January 2022 at 7pm at Drayton Village Hall, Drayton, NR8 6PP

1. Apologies and consideration of acceptance for absence

Apologies for absence were received from Kirsty Savage, Neil Quinsey and Jeff Anderson.

2. Members' declarations of interest and requests for dispensations

a) Adrian Crotch declared a non-pecuniary interest in item '9 a)' to the agenda due to his role at Broadland District Councillor for Drayton North.

3. Minutes from Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 2nd December 2021

a) The following amendments were made:

- i. Page 1 Change location from Drayton Village Hall to the King George Fifth Pavilion.

With these amendments the minutes were **AGREED** and signed by the Chair as a true and correct record.

4. Co-option to the Parish Council

No applications received.

5. To receive any questions or comments from members of the Public on matters on the agenda.

- a) A representative from Thorpe Marriott Village Hall raised concerns for the implementation of private management for the carpark at 'The Square' in Thorpe Marriott. The landowner has not previously implemented parking charges.
 - i. The carpark services various facilities and shops including the Village Hall, Church, public house, and other retail outlets. Customers are now restricted to one hour of free parking unless they are in possession of a permit.
 - ii. Further comment was made on the lack of clearly marked parking bays as well as the residual effect the charges will have on other local services and activities including bowls teams, weddings, children's parties, elections, and annual Christmas fair, etc.

- iii. Increased numbers of cars are parking on nearby Acres Way and Pendlesham Rise.
 - iv. Stuart Clancy (Norfolk County Councillor and Broadland District Councillor for Taverham/Thorpe Marriott) is pursuing negotiations with the landowner regarding how best to support everyone's interests.
- b) It was commented that staff members at Thorpe Marriott Tesco had been able to register their vehicle so are exempt from charges. The Tesco Drayton Community Champion also thanked everyone who supported the Christmas Giving Tree initiative.

6. To receive any reports:

- a) County Councillor Tony Adams also reported on the carpark situation at 'The Square' in Thorpe Marriott and confirmed that a meeting date between Stuart Clancy and the landowner was being sought. Planning permission for 46 Taverham Road was granted on appeal.
- b) Drayton North District Councillor Adrian Crotch updated on the 'community connectors' scheme which operates out of local surgeries in support of patients covering a wide range of health and well-being issues. Drayton Surgery will be participating in the scheme, having a dedicated 'connector' present in the surgery providing consultations on issues such as housing debt, welfare, parental challenges, mental health, relationships, social isolation, domestic abuse, technology, health, and exercise. Referrals for this service can be made by healthcare professionals, councillors, and community groups. Update on the Marriott's Way resurfacing works; concerns have been raised over the quality of the finish as well as the aesthetics. Stuart Clancy has been informed with proposals for further soft landscaping and works to level the Drayton/Tesco end of the path. The monitoring office have confirmed that the notion to hold meetings over a media platform has been refused. Meetings of the Council must therefore continue to take place in person. Written confirmation of this should be received in the coming week and will remain subject to review.
- c) Drayton South District Councillor Roger Foulger was not present.
- d) PC Alex Wright reported small amount of anti-social behaviour over the festive period including incidences of 'knock and run' in the vicinity of a disputed shortcut on Acres Way. The shortcut is on private land which has now been fenced off by the landowner. Speed enforcement has continued. PC Wright would like to encourage the local community to assist with speed watch and requested the Parish Council support this if possible. It was reported that the engagement activities held at Longdale had been successful and would continue.
- e) The Tree Warden, Andrew Baker suggested considering the planting of a permanent fir tree for Christmas though concern was raised as to the size and upkeep of a permanent tree. Placement of three trees at the Florence Carter

Memorial Playing Field has been carried out satisfactorily. Further trees should be placed at King George Fifth Playing Field as soon as possible with a view to dedicate them in June 2022. Add item to the Open Spaces Agenda to determine the placement of the trees.

8. Planning

- a) The following planning applications were considered:
 - i. 20212092 12 Jordan Close: Replacement of existing roof with bi-fold doors. It was **AGREED** to send no comment/objection.
 - ii. 20212126 6 George Drive: Proposed rear extension, proposed porch and front infill extension, alteration of existing roof pitch with rear flat roof dormer including associated internal alterations. Detached outbuilding in rear garden. It was **AGREED** to send no comments/objections.

 - iii. 20212342 – 17 Carter Road, Drayton, NR8 6DY. Single storey rear extension, internal alterations, and detached garage. Received 6/1/22. Decision delayed until 3rd February 2022 Full Parish Council meeting.
 - iv. 20212274 – Drayton Old Lodge, 146 Drayton High Road, Drayton, NR8 6AN. Variation of condition 1 of 20210951 – amendments to layouts including relocation of footpath links to Drayton High Road and design of dwellings. Received 6/1/22. Decision delayed until 3rd February 2022 Full Parish Council meeting.

- b) The following planning decisions had been received:

9. Streetlights

- a) Broadland has confirmed the handover of streetlighting to Drayton Parish Council with a projected date of 01/04/22. A minimum sum of £49157.04 will be awarded to assist in covering the associated costs including pending maintenance and upgrades. Consideration given to whether we should takeover lights positioned on private land. Several questions have been sent to Broadland District Council regarding the details of the takeover for which the Council awaits a reply. Further updates also pending regarding types of bulbs, condition of posts and information for power companies so that quotes can be sought.

- b) Design and specification for Manor Park Street lighting needs to be followed up. No response has been received from Hopkins Homes. Similarly, no response has been received from Norfolk Homes for the development on Fakenham Road.

10. Finance and Governance

- a) The bank reconciliation was received & **APPROVED**.
- b) The list of payments and receipts was **APPROVED**, proposed by Graham Everett, seconded by Carl Brown, all in favour. 2 additional receipts were presented and **APPROVED**.
- c) The Budget and Precept 2022/23 was received and after 2 amendments was **APPROVED**. The Precept approved is £186,990. Amount proposed by Graham Everett, seconded by Angie Taylor. All others agreed. Keith Morgan abstained.
- d) Adrian Crotch commented that the residents would see a significant increase in the parish precept on their council tax bill even though the Special Charges would be removed and asked if there was a plan to accompany the bills with an explanation for the change. Broadland District Council have been approached regarding this and have provided information in the past. Confirmation that this will be carried out still required and detail as to the content.

- a) Greater Norwich Local Plan Examination Hearings – 1st February 2022 noted
- b) Email received from Damon Williams as well as other correspondence from parishioners regarding the introduction of parking charges in Thorpe Marriott. It was discussed how best the Council could support their views and concerns. Concern expressed for the social impact of the charges and the potential economic impact to local businesses. It was proposed that a letter should be drafted with the aim of expressing support for an amicable resolution to the

issue for both the community and the landowner. The letter could then be shared on social media and on the Drayton Parish Council website to reassure parishioners of the Council's support for their concerns. Stuart Clancy to be copied into any correspondence.

- b) It was commented that the Open Spaces and Property committee were not consulted regarding the tree planting at the Florence Carter Memorial Playing Field. In future, they would like to be consulted before business within their remit is undertaken.

- c) It would be useful to discuss 'lessons learned' from the Christmas light switch on. It was suggested that a meeting in February on zoom would be useful to discuss ideas for Christmas 2022. In particular, the need for road closure.
